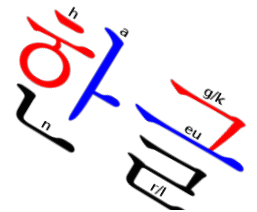
Spanish, Korean, Russian, English, and more!
